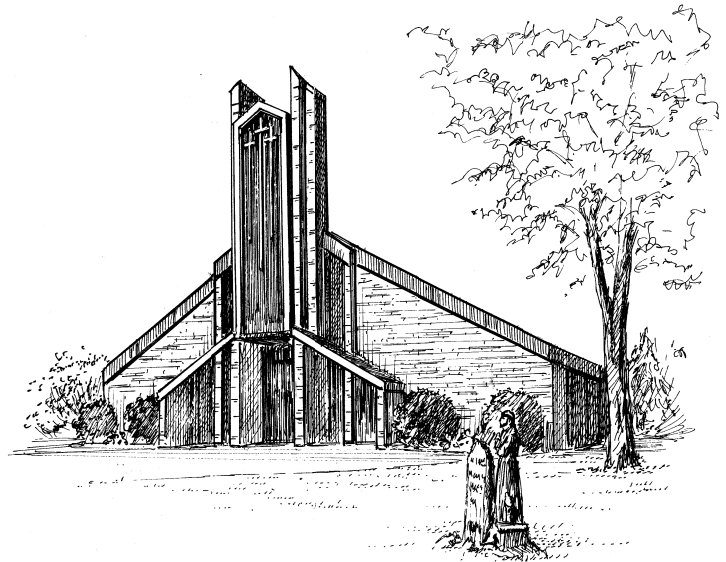

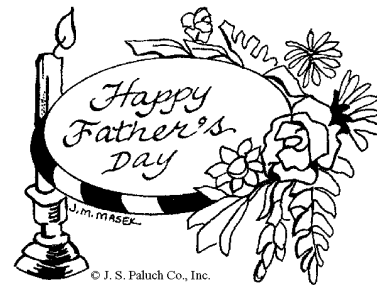

St. Joseph High School is looking for a family to host a Chinese Teacher for the 2010-2011 school year. The ideal family will be willing to open their hearts and home to a well educated teacher who will in exchange gain the perspective of life in America through your eyes.
